Not a “question and guess the correct answer” approach, but a discernment process for which we all might learn something valuable. This year we gather to look at the book of “Ephesians” over a period of 7 weeks in July – August, being guided by N.T. Wrights book “Ephesians for Everyone” (\$13).
