PARKING RESTRICTION CHANGES – HYSLOP STREET: We have been advised by Boroondara Council that changes are soon to be made introduce a **Permit Zone, 6PM to 8 AM** restriction on the north side of Hyslop Street from No 5 to the corner of Myrniong Street so as to guarantee overnight parking space for residents. This will supplement the existing **2 Hour 8AM to 6 PM Monday to Friday** restriction which is currently in place along that part of the street. BUC Congregation members and other people using the church premises in the evenings should note this change and park their vehicles accordingly.
