## Message from minister Paul

Grace and peace be with all of you.

As we move beyond Easter Sundays according to the church calendar, it is a time for us to fix our gaze upon the resurrected Jesus with great hope because we know how the lives of the disciples who experienced the resurrection were completely transformed.

In his book "Surprised by Hope," N.T. Wright emphasizes the significance of the Resurrection, stating, "Take away the stories of Jesus' birth, and all you lose is two chapters of Matthew and two of Luke. Take away the resurrection and you lose the entire New Testament... (p.54)" As Christians, we are called to be people of the Resurrection, as it is both the starting point of Christianity and the ultimate destination of the new creation. Unfortunately, in our current era, many people, including some Christians, hold skeptical attitudes or deny the resurrection for various reasons. This has led the church to lose its sense of direction and energy.

Beloved members of the BUC congregation, we have experienced firsthand how our lives are shaped by our beliefs and thoughts. In the same book, Wright argues, "Believing in the

resurrection of Jesus suddenly ceases to be a matter of inquiring about an odd event in the first century and becomes a matter of rediscovering hope in the twenty-first century. Hope is what you get when you suddenly realize that a different worldview is possible, a worldview in which the rich, the powerful, and the unscrupulous do not have the last word. The same worldview shift demanded by the resurrection of Jesus is what will enable us to transform the world. (p.87)"

I firmly believe that, in order to live as citizens of God's Kingdom, we need a proper understanding and unwavering faith in the Resurrection. As we journey through this Easter season, in an age dominated by scientific discourse, may the BUC congregation comprehend and embrace the resurrection through the language of faith, hope, and love. May we be blessed to actively participate in the unfolding of the new creation amidst the world.
